I am submitting this request pursuant to the "Mississippi Public Records Act (Miss. Code § 25-61-1 et seq.)". ## Background The City of Jackson recently transitioned its official website from a ProuDCity-hosted platform (jacksonms.gov, powered by Google Cloud/WordPress) to a new website platform. Following this transition, the city's Council Agendas & Minutes page at https://www.jacksonms.gov/council-agendas-and-minutes/ no longer contains the meeting minutes, agendas, and related documents that were previously available on the prior site. Under Mississippi law, the City is required to maintain and provide public access to these records: - "Miss. Code § 25-41-11" requires that minutes of all public body meetings be kept and open to public inspection. - "Miss. Code § 25-61-5" requires that public records be available for inspection by any person. - "Miss. Code § 21-8-11(2)" requires that yeas and nays be recorded on every council vote. - "Miss. Code § 21-15-33" requires council minutes be adopted within 30 days. The website transition has resulted in the removal or inaccessibility of legally required public documents. I am requesting records to understand the circumstances of this transition. ## Records Requested ## 1. Website Redesign Contract & Procurement - The "contract or agreement" between the City of Jackson and the vendor selected to redesign, host, or manage the new city website, including all amendments, addenda, and statements of work. - The "Request for Proposals (RFP)", "Request for Qualifications (RFQ)", or other solicitation documents issued for the website redesign project. - All "vendor proposals or bids" received in response to the solicitation. - The "evaluation or scoring documents" used to select the winning vendor. - The "name of the vendor" awarded the contract, the "contract amount", and the "contract term" (start date, end date, renewal options). ## 2. Under Mississippi's "Open Meetings Act (Miss. Code § 25-41-11)", minutes of all public meetings are required to be kept and made available to the public: > "Minutes shall be kept of all meetings of public bodies... Such minutes shall be open to public inspection during regular business hours." Additionally, under the "Mississippi Public Records Act (Miss. Code § 25-61-5)", public records shall be made available to any person: > "... it is the policy of the Legislature that public records must be available for inspection by any person unless otherwise provided by this act." These records — meeting minutes and agendas of the City Council — are core public documents that the city is already obligated to maintain and make publicly accessible.
