The collision was investigated by the Jackson Police Department under the above case number. Officer Keyshawn McInnis (Badge No. 2632) was the investigating officer, and Sergeant Bennie Chisholm reviewed the report. Pursuant to the Mississippi Public Records Act, Miss. Code Ann. Section 25-61-1 et seq., and Miss. Code Ann. Section 63-3-417, I respectfully request copies of the following public records relating to this collision: All body-worn camera (BWC) recordings created by Officer Keyshawn McInnis (Badge No. 2632) between 10:30 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. on June 15, 2026. All body-worn camera recordings created by any other Jackson Police Department officer who responded to, was present at, or assisted in the investigation of this collision, during the same time period. All dash-mounted or in-car camera recordings from the patrol vehicle operated by Officer McInnis, and from any other Jackson Police Department unit that responded to the scene, during the same time period. All computer-aided dispatch (CAD) records, dispatch logs, and call-for-service records relating to this collision, including the initial call, the assignment of units, response and clearance times, and any on-scene communications. All radio traffic recordings and radio logs relating to this collision. All 911 call recordings and associated call-detail or CAD entries relating to this collision. All photographs and video recordings taken by any Jackson Police Department officer or employee at the scene, including images of the vehicles, the roadway, the point of impact, debris, skid or yaw marks, final rest positions, and the tractor-trailer involved. 26-1307	To Whom It May Concern: My name is Matthew Hart, and I am a paralegal with The Federal Concierge, a legal support and records retrieval service that assists incarcerated individuals and their families with obtaining public records and investigating potential detainees or pending state matters. We are currently assisting Mr. Dominique Desha Mathews, who is presently in the custody of the Federal Bureau of Prisons. Mr. Mathews has been advised by BOP staff that an allegedly open homicide-related matter exists in Mississippi and that the Jackson Police Department is identified as the arresting agency associated with the matter. Mr. Mathews reports that he has never been arrested or otherwise notified regarding such a case. He further advises that the matter does not appear in his Presentence Investigation Report. The BOP has provided him with the number 230903170, which he believes may be associated with the matter. Our office has conducted preliminary inquiries with local courts in the surrounding jurisdictions and has been unable to identify a corresponding court case. We have also been advised that the number provided does not appear to match the case numbering format utilized by those courts.
