26-1359	Appeal and Request for Reconsideration of Public Records Request Denials (Nos. 26-1108, 26-1109 & 26-1110) Dear Jackson Police Department: EWU Media LLC respectfully appeals and requests reconsideration of the Jackson Police Department's June 10, 2026 denials of Public Records Request Nos. 26-1108, 26-1109, and 26-1110, submitted May 30, 2026, concerning Joseph Brown and the Jackson Police Department's investigation of First-Degree Murder, Drive-By Shooting, and Aggravated Assault arising from the December 15, 2021 incident on Beasley Road in Jackson, Mississippi. The Department denied Request Nos. 26-1108 and 26-1109 under Miss. Code Ann. § 25-61-12(2)(a). The Department denied Request No. 26-1110 under Miss. Code Ann. §§ 19-5-319(2) and 25-61-12(2)(a). EWU Media does not contend that every requested record must be released in full. This appeal requests that the Department apply the cited exemptions by record category, confirm whether responsive records exist, release non-exempt records and reasonably segregable portions where permitted, and provide a specific statutory basis for any continued withholding. I. Governing Standard The Mississippi Public Records Act, Miss. Code Ann. § 25-61-1 et seq., provides access to public records unless otherwise provided by law. Section 25-61-12(2)(a) exempts investigative reports in the possession of a law enforcement agency, but also states that the agency, in its discretion, may make public all or any part of an investigative report. The Department's denial letters quote § 25-61-12(2)(a), but do not state whether each requested category was reviewed separately, whether responsive records exist, whether non-exempt portions can be released, or whether the Department exercised the discretion expressly preserved by the statute. The Act also distinguishes incident reports from investigative reports. A law enforcement incident report is not automatically exempt from disclosure merely because investigative material may also exist. II. Incident/Offense Report Information Request No. 26-1110, Item 4 Request No. 26-1110 sought police reports, including incident, narrative, and supplemental reports. The Department denied the entire category under § 25-61-12(2)(a). EWU Media respectfully requests that the Department separate non-exempt incident/offense information from investigative narrative or supplemental material. At minimum, EWU Media requests release of public incident-report information, including the name and identification of each person charged with and arrested for the offense, the time, date, and location of the alleged offense, and property involved, to the extent known and non-exempt. If the Department maintains that narrative or supplemental portions contain exempt investigative material, those portions should be reviewed separately and redacted only as necessary. The existence of investigative material does not justify withholding all incident/offense information. III. Mugshot / Booking Photograph Request No. 26-1110, Item 8 Request No. 26-1110 sought all mugshots of the suspect in relation to the case. The Department denied this category under the same investigative-report exemption. A mugshot or booking photograph is commonly an arrest-identification record created during booking. The denial letter does not explain why the requested mugshot falls within § 25-61-12(2)(a) or identify any mugshot-specific exemption. EWU Media respectfully requests that the Department review the requested mugshot separately and release it unless a specific statutory exemption applies. IV. Body-Worn Camera Footage Request No. 26-1109 Request No. 26-1109 sought all body-worn camera footage related to the case. The Department denied the request under § 25-61-12(2)(a). Even if some responsive body-worn camera footage is treated as investigative material, § 25-61-12(2)(a) permits discretionary release of all or part of such records.
