Code Ann. §§ 25-61-1 et seq. As background, we highlight that we are making this request for scholarly purposes and not commercial use. I am an assistant professor at Augsburg University and my colleague, Professor Ganju, is an assistant professor at the University of Minnesota. We are conducting a national academic research study of certain predictive policing data that we believe will be helpful to the public and law enforcement. We seek specific government data relating to the Department's use of predictive policing technology to evaluate whether these technologies help prevent or solve crimes. Our request is supported by the Mississippi Public Records Act, which declares that "it is the policy of the Legislature that public records must be available for inspection by any person unless otherwise provided by this act." See Miss. Code Ann. § 25-61-1. Furthermore, the Act mandates that "any person shall have the right to inspect, copy or mechanically reproduce or obtain a reproduction of any public record of a public body." See Miss. Code Ann. § 25-61-5(1)(a). The specific requests below will help us identify and analyze if police departments have predictive policing software. Predictive policing products, systems, and tools are more specifically defined in our enclosure with this Letter.
