According to investigators, the incident stemmed from a dispute involving access to social media accounts and a friend request, which escalated into a physical confrontation. Authorities stated that Wallace allegedly fired a warning shot as Reed approached her, and after he refused to back down, she shot him. Wallace then reportedly performed CPR on her husband and called 911. Damion Reed was later pronounced dead. Wallace was subsequently arrested and charged with murder and held at the Hinds County Detention Center.
