In response, the Department produced a redacted initial incident report associated with Case No. 26-0609291 and advised that additional investigative records were being withheld pursuant to exemptions under the Mississippi Public Records Act. After reviewing the records produced, I respectfully request additional clarification and production of the following records. 1. Although the Department's August 7 response expressly identifies Case No. 26-0707173 as one of the cases encompassed by my request, I did not identify an incident or offense report for that case among the records produced.
