Fire investigators determined that the fire was intentionally set. The blaze caused significant damage to the synagogue's administrative and library areas and destroyed or damaged several Torah scrolls and other religious materials. Investigators from the Jackson Fire Department, Jackson Police Department, FBI, ATF, Mississippi Bureau of Investigation, and other law enforcement agencies participated in the investigation. A suspect, later identified as 19-year-old Stephen Spencer Pittman, was taken into custody on January 10 after he was located at the University of Mississippi Medical Center being treated for non-life-threatening burn injuries. Investigators subsequently alleged that Pittman had intentionally set the fire and that the synagogue was targeted because of its Jewish ties. Charges: Arson; federal charge of maliciously damaging or destroying a building by means of fire or an explosive; First-Degree Arson of a Place of Worship with a hate-crime enhancement under Mississippi law I am specifically requesting all available body-worn camera footage from Jackson Police Department officers and any other law enforcement officers who responded to, investigated, or participated in the arrest of Stephen Spencer Pittman on January 10, 2026. I am also requesting any available dashcam/in-car camera footage from law enforcement vehicles involved in responding to the Beth Israel Congregation fire, investigating the incident, locating Pittman, or taking Pittman into custody at the University of Mississippi Medical Center. Code Ann. §§ 25611 et seq., I hereby request the following public records: All records pertaining to a JPD officer who was filmed performing stunt driving maneuvers ("half donuts") in a marked JPD patrol vehicle in the parking lot of the CSL Plasma center on Northbrook Drive in Jackson, Mississippi, on or about Sunday, May 18, 2026. Video of the incident circulated publicly beginning May 19, 2026. Chief RaShall Brackney confirmed that an internal investigation was underway on May 20, 2026. Specific Records Requested: 1. The internal affairs complaint or incident report regarding this incident 2. The full name and badge number of the officer involved 3. The officer's assignment, precinct, and shift at the time of the incident 4. Any written statements from witnesses, including civilian witnesses and JPD personnel 5. The final disposition of the investigation and any disciplinary action imposed 6. All bodyworn camera (BWC) footage and incar (dash) camera footage from the marked patrol vehicle involved, covering the timeframe of 6:00 PM to midnight on May 18, 2026 7. Any BWC footage from any JPD officer who responded to, witnessed, or was otherwise present during the incident 8. Any suspension records, disciplinary notices, or letters of reprimand related to this incident 9. The officer's disciplinary history for the preceding five (5) years 10. The vehicle identification number (VIN), unit number, and assignment records for the patrol vehicle involved 11. Any GPS, AVL, or telemetry data from that vehicle for May 18, 2026, from 6:00 PM to midnight 12. Any radio communications (dispatch logs) related to the incident 13. Any text messages or other electronic communications between JPD personnel regarding the incident or the viral video 14. All correspondence, memoranda, and emails related to this investigation Legal Basis for Disclosure: I am aware of the following exemptions that JPD may invoke, and I submit the following responses: 1. § 25611(2)(1) — Officer Privacy Exemption. This statute exempts only the home address and private telephone numbers of law enforcement officers. I am not requesting these. The officer's name, badge number, and on-duty assignment are public records. This exemption does not extend to the identity of an officer performing official duties in a marked vehicle in a public parking lot. 2. § 25611(2)(a) — Investigative Reports. Investigative reports in the possession of a law enforcement agency are exempt. However, this exemption applies to criminal investigations, not internal affairs matters. The Mississippi Supreme Court has held that internal affairs investigations into officer misconduct are separate from criminal investigations and are generally subject to public disclosure. See Hinds County Board of Supervisors v. Common Cause of Mississippi, 551 So. 2d 107 (Miss. 1989) (personnel records may be inspected in whole or in part by any person). Furthermore, the statute provides that "a law enforcement agency, in its discretion, may choose to make public all or any part of any investigative report" — I request that JPD exercise that discretion here. 3. § 25611(2)(c) — Incident Reports Are Not Exempt. This subsection states: "Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to exempt from public disclosure a law enforcement incident report." An incident report is defined in § 25613(e) to include the name and identification of each person charged, the time, date, and location of the alleged offense. 4. § 25615(2) — Redaction Obligation. If any record contains both exempt and nonexempt material, JPD is required to redact the exempted material and produce the remainder. I accept redactions where legally required. 5. Body Camera Footage. BWC footage of on-duty officers performing official functions in a public place is a public record. The May 18, 2026 incident was a confirmed administrative/internal matter — not a pending criminal investigation. The footage should be disclosed in its native digital format.
