The Mississippi Ethics Commission's Model Public Records Rules, Rule 3.1, state that records of public business on employees' home computers "are 'public records' and are subject to disclosure," and that the public body "should direct the employee to forward any responsive documents back to the public body." MDAH's Email Management Guidelines apply "regardless of the device or account used to create it, including personal/home email accounts." I ask the City to follow that procedure.
