Prosecutors alleged that Gino Washington shot Hancock, took Hancock's keys and cell phone, and fled in Hancock's Toyota Scion. The article states that Washington was later identified by Gilmore and that police linked him to Hancock's stolen cell phone through LeadsOnline after Washington allegedly sold the phone at an ecoATM kiosk in Jackson on July 9, 2018. During the trial, an interrogation video of Washington was shown in which he denied involvement in the murder. Source of Incident Information: WLBT, July 8, 2021.
